

CUSTOMIZING THE GENERATE X SHOPPING CART

Open a text editing program. TextEdit on Mac, or Notepad on PC work well for this.

Textedit - open Preferences. In the "Open and Save" window, place a check mark by the "Ignore rich text commands in HTML files."

Notepad - Go to File>Open. In the drop down list for file type where it has "text documents (.txt)", change it to "all files."

Open the **SubPage.htm** file which is found at:

WINDOWS USERS: **Program Files/Adobe/Photoshop CS3/Presets/Web Photo Gallery/GX-templatename/SubPage.htm**

MAC USERS: **Adobe Photoshop CS3/Presets/Web Photo GalleryGX-templatename/SubPage.htm**

In the top part of the document (also known as the <head> section), you'll find the following code:

(Note - Shading and colors are for explanation purposes, and are not in the actual code)

You can leave this first one alone. It's for the top line of the drop down list where the word "select" is right now, which we'll get to on the next page.

This area here represents the items on your drop down list for products and pricing, and where you customize the cart. The area in the gray box has 6 lines and represents ONE item. Notice it starts with the word if and ends with a }. There are three items on this list and on the template. You can make this list as long or short as you need by copying or deleting the 6 lines of code for each item.

You only need to edit the two values marked in blue for each item, which assign the name and price. Be sure to keep each line of code on the same line as it is here, and don't delete or add any > % } " ; = < { , or change any other code. It's important 😊

Now scroll down to the lower part of the same page (the <body> section), and you'll find the following code. Edit the values making sure not to delete any < " % { ; + > or } . Use the same item values you put in the first section.

Put the same email address you use to sign into PayPal between the " ".
*note - Your password is private and is not needed anywhere for the cart to work.

Here are the items on the drop down list with their names and prices again. Edit only the values marked in blue. The values to the right of the > are what your customer will actually see in the drop down menu. The option values marked in blue to the left (inside the < > tags) are what will be on the order form. Use as many item lines as you need, or delete the ones you don't. Just be sure to keep the whole line of code for each item on its own line, just like shown here.

If your template includes the extra drop down menu for "Options", then edit this section. This section works the same as the drop down list above, but is for the product options - not price. Change only the values in blue. If you need more or less options, copy/paste or delete as many lines as you need. If you do not want this option menu, delete from where it says "Beginning of Options Menu" to "End of Options Menu."

If the currency you accept and set up in your PayPal account (Profile > Currency Balances) is other than USD (US Dollar), then insert that currency code here between the " ". On the next line, put your two letter country code between the " ".

That's it! Save the file in the same location, with the same name: **SubPage.htm**

When you use the template, it is important to name the gallery (in the control panel under Banner), and to check the box for "Filename" under the options for the Large Image so orders will be properly identified. Gallery name and file name will be listed on the order you receive after a purchase is made.

Run the template and verify the cart displays and works correctly, ie: the drop down list looks correct, buttons are where they belong, and the Add to Cart/View Cart buttons connect to your PayPal account with the correct currency. If anything is wrong, check the code carefully using the above example as a guide to be sure there are no line breaks in the code, or pieces of code that might have accidentally been deleted or added, and no typos in your email address. If you test the cart before you customized it, and you are not using USD for your currency, then make sure the cart is empty and then try it again.
